These recommendations will be made after reviewing your overall medical condition and the treatment you are scheduled for. We believe this individualized approach allows us to focus limited resources while still maintaining your oral health and your overall health. If you have any cold, flu symptoms or a fever, we ask that you notify us so we can reschedule your appointment. Please also inform us if you have traveled in the prior two weeks.

DO NOT GO TO THE HOSPITAL EMERGENCY ROOM OR URGENT CARE CENTER WITH A DENTAL EMERGENCY. Call your dentist. We will be available for our patients and patients who do not have a dentist of record.

As circumstances change, we will provide updates. In the meantime, we encourage you to follow all CDC and state of Oregon guidelines to protect your health and the health of all of us. Stay safe.
